Course Title	COVID-19 and Infectious Disease Response Awareness Training Course
Course Short Description	This course is designed to increase workers' knowledge of hazards they may encounter on a job site related to potential occupational exposures to SARS CoV-2 virus that causes COVID-19. Training will explain what is SARS-CoV-2, how is it spread, symptoms, how to protect workers, cleaning and disinfecting, and vaccination.
