AGREEMENT DATED MAY 26, 1955
BETWEEN RAILROADS REPRESENTED BY THE
EASTERN, WESTERN AND SOUTHEASTERN
CARRIERS' CONFERENCE COMMITTEES
AND THE EMPLOYEES OF SUCH RAILROADS
REPRESENTED BY THE
BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD TRAINMEN
AMENDING ARTICLE I OF THE
AGREEMENT OF MAY 11, 1955

A G R E E M E N T

This Agreement made this 26th day of May, 1955, by and between the participating carriers listed in Exhibits A, B and C attached to an Agreement of May 11, 1955 to which this Agreement is Supplemental and made a part thereof and represented by the EASTERN, WESTERN AND SOUTH - EASTERN CARRIERS' CONFERENCE COMMITTEES and the employees shown thereon and represented by the BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD TRAINMEN through its conference committee.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

Pursuant to further negotiations conducted between the committees named above, Article I of the Agreement of May 11, 1955 is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE I -

(a) Road Freight Conductors and Trainmen

Effective June 16, 1955, the basic daily rates of pay for conductors, brakemen and flagmen in road freight service receiving road rates of pay shall be increased as follows:

Basis of Pay

Maximum number of cars (including caboose) hauled in train in road movement at any one time on road trip anywhere between initial starting point and point of final release.

Amounts to be added to the Basic Daily Road Freight Rates in effect as of June 15, 1955

Conductors, Brakemen and Flagmen

Less than 81 cars	\$.20
81 to 105 cars	.55
106 to 125 cars	.95
126 to 145 cars	1.20
146 to 165 cars	1.30

Add 20¢ for each additional block of 20 cars or portion thereof.

NOTE:

Where under existing rules or practices on an individual carrier arbitraries or special allowances are made by reason of the tonnage or the number of cars handled in a train, such arbitraries or special allowances, or the amount produced by the above table, whichever is the greater, shall apply, but not both.

(b) Road Passenger Conductors, Assistant Conductors (Ticket Collectors), Baggage-men, Flagmen and Brakemen

Effective June 16, 1955, an adjustment of 20 cents will be made by adding that amount to the respective daily rates of pay of conductors, assistant conductors (ticket collectors), baggage-men, flagmen and brakemen in passenger service.

(c) Dining Car Stewards

Effective June 16, 1955, all basic monthly rates of pay shall be increased \$5.00.

(d) In determining new hourly rates, fractions of a cent will be disposed of by applying next higher quarter of a cent.

Mileage rates shall be determined by dividing the new daily rates by the miles constituting a basic day's work in the respective classes of service.

Existing money differentials above existing standard daily rates shall be maintained.

(e) This Supplemental Agreement is in full and final settlement of the dispute growing out of Paragraph 1 of notices served by the employees parties hereto on or about June 7, 1954, in accordance with Section 6 of the Railway Labor Act, as amended.
