STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim of Ronald T. McBride for reinstatement, with clear record, and pay for all time lost on account of being dismissed following Formal Investigation held March 17, 1986.

FINDINGS:

The Fourth Division of the Adjustment Board upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

The procedural issues presented by this Claim have been addressed in full by Fourth Division Award 4683, and we hereby adopt the reasoning set forth therein. Accordingly, this Claim is dismissed.
