United Transportation Union (YM) as the Representative of K. D. Edwards

VS.

Consolidated Rail Corporation

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim is one days pay for attending the hearing and clear the service record of K. D. Edwards of the charges.

OPINION OF BOARD:

The record establishes that the parties to this controversy are Carrier and Employee as defined in the Railway Labor Act, as amended and this Board is duly constituted and has jurisdiction to hear this dispute.

Claimant was assigned as 3rd Trick Yardmaster at Island Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa. on November 17, 1992. On that date, the second trick yardmaster completed a work order for the crew of WIMCO8 advising them to be aware there were 215.9 shop cars at Allenport and to place them on the head end to be delivered to Conway for repair. The second trick Yardmaster's turnover sheet to the third trick (Claimant) shows the markup with the advise to keep the shop cars on the head end. The Claimant's transfer check to the first trick Yardmaster does not contain the same information. In any event, the two cars were placed in trains and dispatched with their shop cards affixed. They

FINDINGS: The Agreement was violated.

AWARD: Claim Sustained.

ORDER: Carrier is directed to make this Award effective forty-five (45) days from this date. Dated at
